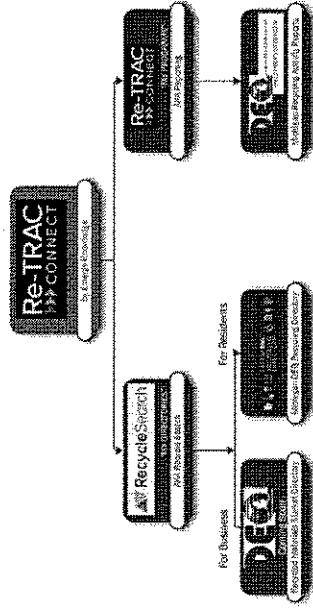


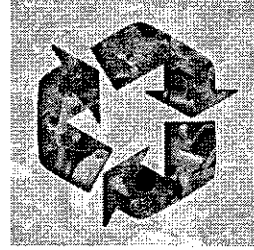

What is it?

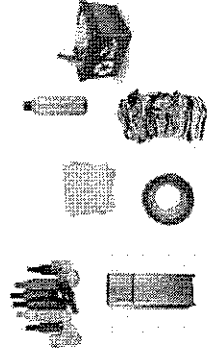


- Overall umbrella for:

- Name for reporting modules
 - All modules found within Re-TRAC
 - Michigan Recycling Activity Reports




Michigan Recycling Activity Reports


- Housed within Re-TRAC
- Governors Recycling Initiative
- Part 175, Recycling Reporting
 - Mandatory reporters
 - 7 reportable recyclable materials
 - Voluntary reporters
 - Wider variety of materials
- Report on materials:
 - Received
 - Shipped
 - In and out of state
- All reports on all types of materials are encouraged



Recycle Search




- Large recycling directory system
- Recycling organizations list their facility, residents find recycling options near them
- Houses multiple individual directories
 - I.e. Michigan DEQ Recycling Directory

 - Includes drop-offs, MRFs, collection events, Ewaste collectors and recyclers, scrap fire collection sites, and many more


Recycled Materials Market Directory
